
Blue Line


















SPECTATOR SAFETY INFORMATION

Please plan your event with safety in mind. The following points may help:

- We have tried to ensure that you will be able to reach your chosen spectator viewing area without walking on the special stage. All the competitors will be travelling at high speeds and spectators are strongly advised NOT to walk on the rally route.
- All spectators are reminded that motorsport can be dangerous and despite us taking all reasonable precautions, unavoidable accidents can happen. In respect of these, you are present at your own risk. We ask that you obey all official and marshals' instructions in relation to your safety and that of others.
- Marshals will warn of approaching cars by use of a whistle, please take this as a final signal to ensure you are stood in a safe place and concentrating on the action.
- Please make sure you dress suitably for the prevailing weather conditions and stout footwear is strongly recommended.
- Children and infants should ALWAYS be accompanied by an adequate number of adults at all times who are responsible for their behaviour and safety.
- Stay above the track (never below).
- Do no stand in the straight-on position you will be removed.
- Respect the signs and the tape; Yellow and Black is GOOD i.e., it is ok to stand behind this tape, Red and White = a NO GO area, prohibited area MEANS prohibited area.



- Listen to the marshals they are there to help you and ensure the event runs within the safety guidelines prescribed by Motorsport UK, the governing body of UK Motor Sport.
- If you do not abide by the instructions of marshals and event officials, the stage may be stopped or cancelled.

Marshals and officials have the right to work without being abused or threatened. PLEASE TAKE ALL LITTER HOME WITH YOU. Consider your own safety and that of others at all time.









- 1. Choose your spectating area and arrive early.
- 2. Cars will visit the viewing area on three occasions during the day
- 3. First car is due at 8.14am, 11.40pm and 15.06pm
- 4. We have up to 90 cars which have entered the rally; these will pass this point at one per minute.
- 5. Stay in the designated areas and listen to instructions from a marshal.
- 6. You must **NOT** walk on or traverse a track being used by the rally cars, 30 minutes before the first car is due.









DO NOT:

- Stand on the track
- Stand below the level of the track
- Stand in front of arrows or signs
- Stand in Prohibited Areas
- Stand or sit on or near log piles, walls or fences
- Sit close to the edge of the track
- Block escape routes
- Be distracted
- Play games with your safety or that of drivers
- Remove Stage signs or arrows
- Be the one to stop the stage

ALWAYS:


- · Expect the unexpected
- · Listen for approaching cars
- Remain alert
- Leave yourself room to move quickly
- Try to keep behind something solid
- Keep children under supervision
- Keep dogs on a lead
- Do as the Marshals ask
- Help the Marshals to run a safe stage

BE SURE THAT:

- The unexpected can Happen
- If you ignore Marshals' instructions the Stage will be stopped

- Others around you
- The Stage








Cars will approach at speed.
